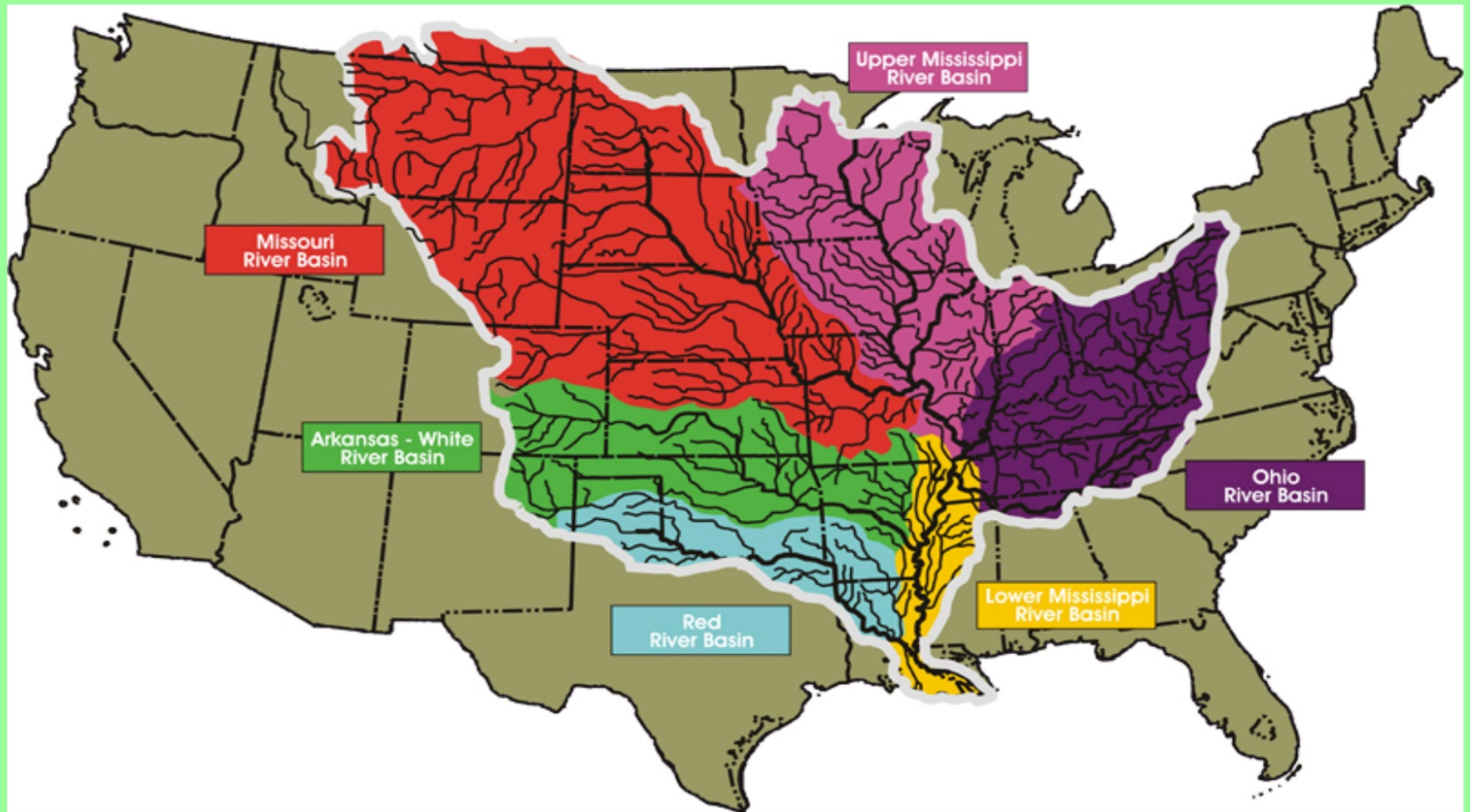

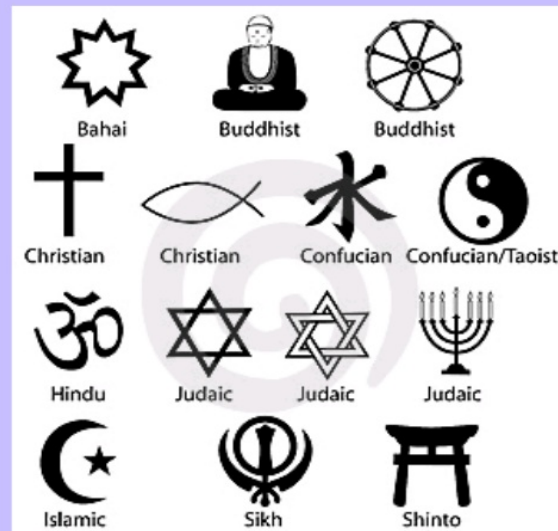

- They can grow larger or smaller for many reasons.

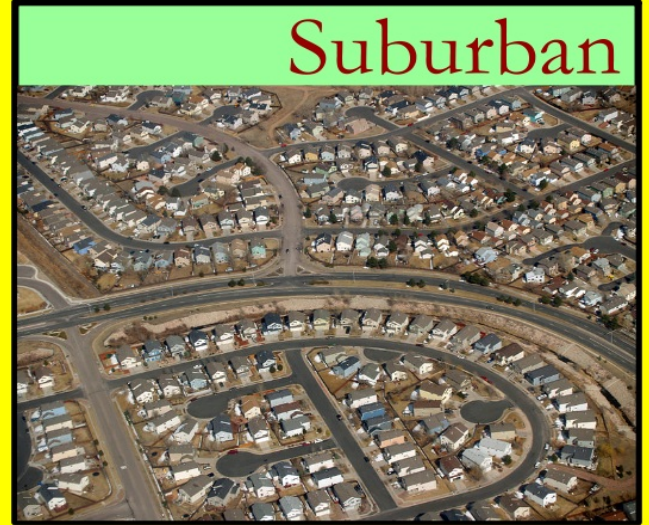

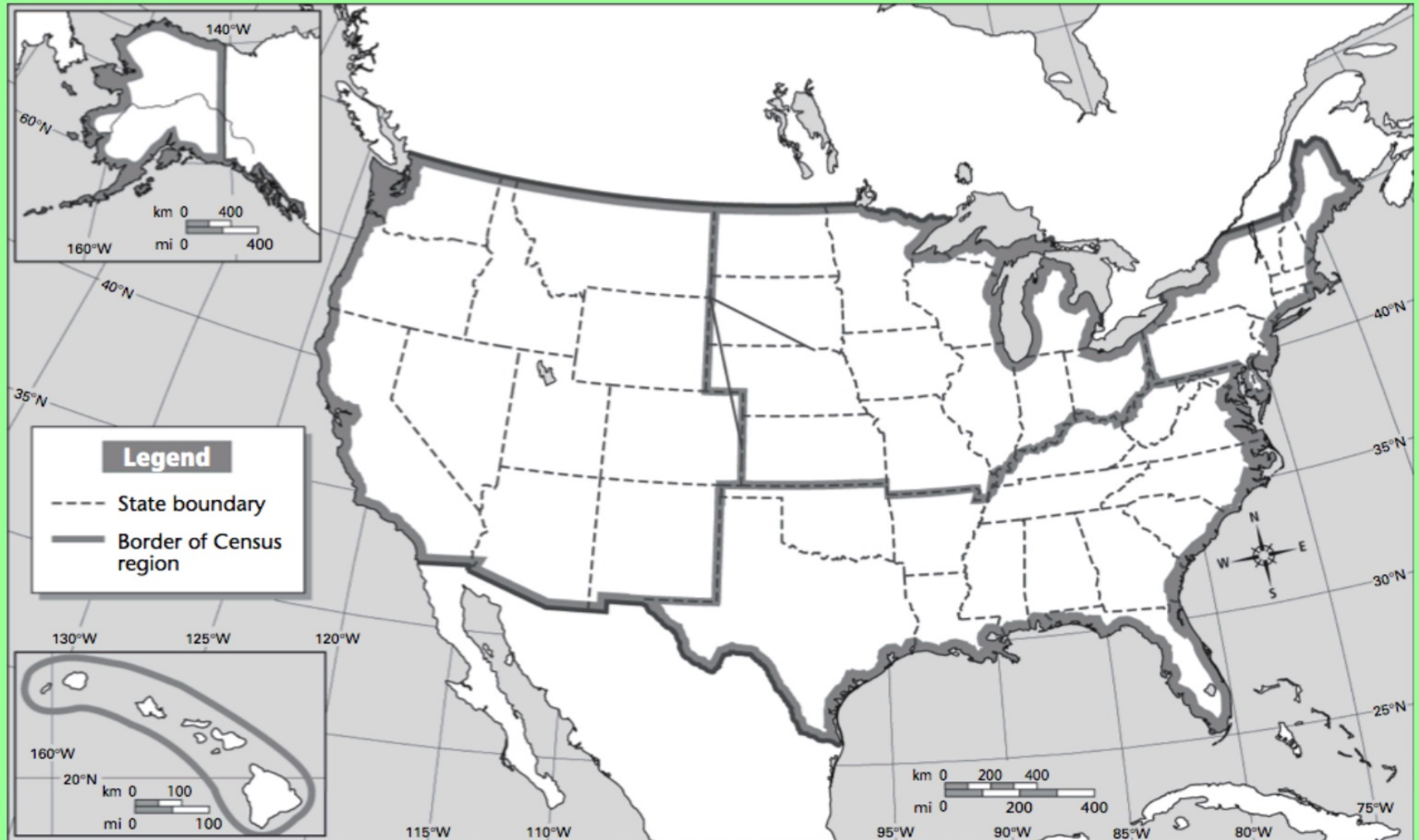
